It is up to us to seek to know God's will and to do his work. The late President John Kennedy, America's only Catholic President, ended his inaugural address with the words; ..." here on earth God's work must truly be our own".

Come Holy Spirit of Pentecost. Come Holy Spirit of the great South Land.

O God, bless and unite all your people in Australia and guide us on the pilgrim way of the plenary council. Give us the grace to see your face in one another and to recognise Jesus our companion on the road.


