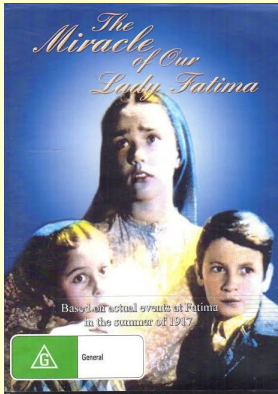

John Paul II. The book is a defence of faith.

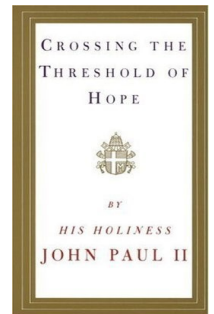

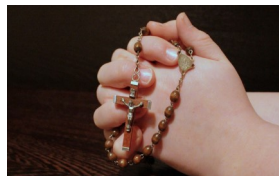


School Rosary Day

In preparation for the 2025 Jubilee Year 'Pilgrims of Hope', Pope Francis designated 2024 to be a Year of Prayer.

This month of October represents a wonderful time to re-energise ourselves with this call to prayer from the Holy Father.

October is the month of the Rosary, a powerful tool for prayer, meditating the life of Our Lord, Jesus Christ.

In the past week, the Holy Father again asked us to pray and fast for peace in our world, amid an escalating conflict in the Middle East.

On Monday, the Diocese joined together at Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral, to pray the Rosary for peace in our world, on the one-year anniversary of the deadly attack on Israel in 2023.

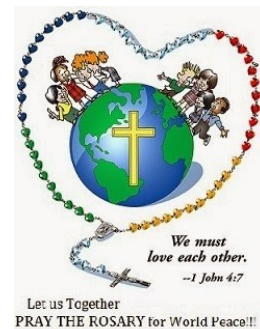
Praying for Peace in the World

During Adoration the Rosary will be prayed for World Peace.

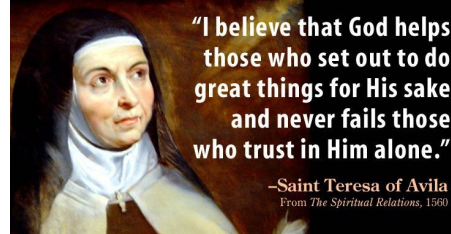

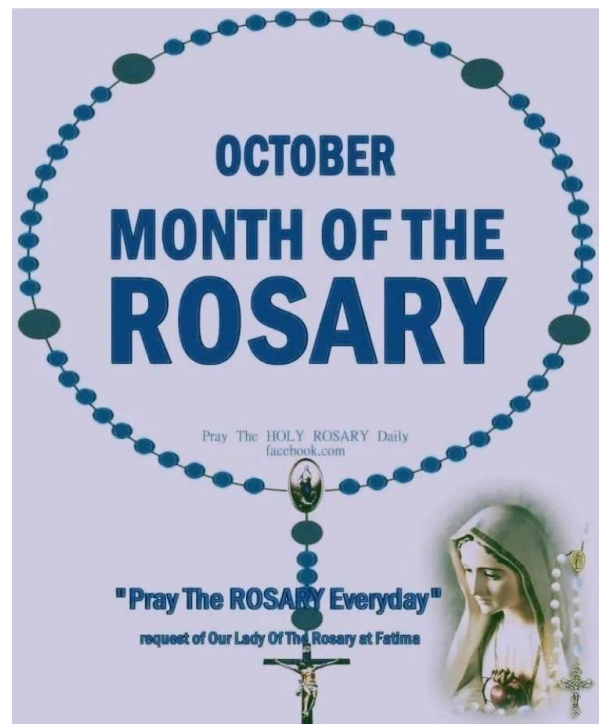


