Remember Christmas is not just day but a season.



The <u>Christmas season</u> immediately follows Advent. The traditional <u>Twelve Days of Christmas</u> begin with <u>Christmas Eve</u> on the evening of <u>December 24</u>



and continue until the feast of <u>Epiphany</u>. The actual Christmas season continues until the <u>Feast of</u> <u>the Baptism of Christ</u>, which in the present form of the Roman Rite is celebrated on the Sunday after January 6, or the following Monday if that Sunday is Epiphany.

The Baptism of the Lord



The Baptism of the Christ is the feast day commemorating the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist.

Accounts of Jesus' baptism are brief but rich in meaning. They reveal him as God's beloved Son and envoy; they

provoke us to a fresh awareness of the mission to which we are called as the baptised. In the Preface for the feast we praise God for our coming "to believe in your Word dwelling among us" and "to know that Christ your Servant has been anointed with the oil of gladness and sent to bring the good news to the oor".

Why did he receive baptism?

The Baptism of Jesus acts as a bridge between the Old Testament prophets (of which John was the last) and the New Testament era of grace and truth.

By entering the waters, Jesus sanctified water and poured forth His grace making all water the future source of salvation.

"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." His baptism is a way in which the Father introduced His Son and His Son's mission to the world.

Today's Feast marks the conclusion of the Christmas Season and the beginning of Ordinary Time. It's a feast of transition from Jesus' hidden life to that of His

public ministry. It also echoes the theme of the Epiphany in that the Baptism of the Lord is another manifestation announcing Jesus' divinity to all of His first followers and to the disciples of John the Baptist.

Lord, I believe that You are the Son of the Eternal Father and the Saviour of the World. I believe that You have brought about a new era of grace and truth and that I am called to follow You wherever You lead. As we begin this liturgical season of Ordinary Time, may it be a time of extraordinary grace in which I daily heed Your voice. Jesus, I trust in You.
