## May the traditional month of Mary

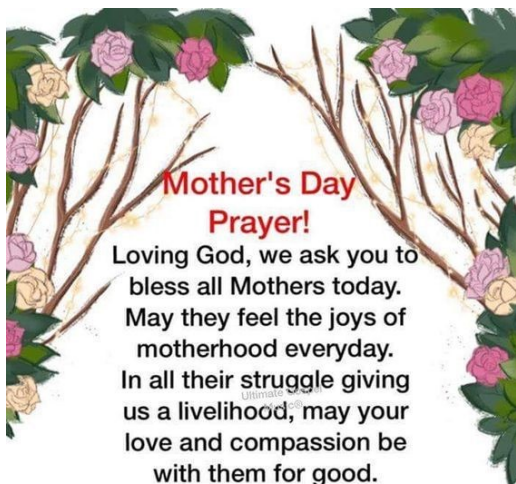


May is traditionally the month we remember our Heavenly Mother. Invitation to join the Rosary which is said every morning in our parish 30 minutes before Mass time.

Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> May, 10 – 11.30am

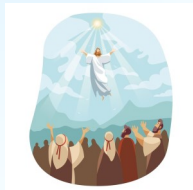
Church in the Café is an initiative of the Parish Pastoral Council to create opportunities for us to come together to share our thoughts and reflections in an informal, social setting.

Through-out the Diocese during the month of May the number of people attending Sunday Masses are being counted, usually around the time of the Preparation of the Gifts.

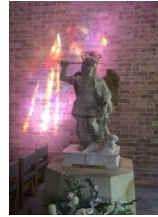
This has been done in Broken Bay for more than 20 years now and the changes in the numbers attending Mass are used as an indicator of the performance of a parish and for future allocation of resources.

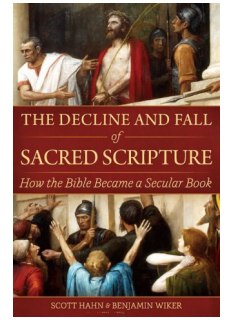
