Plenary Council Report.

Australian Plenary Council for the Catholic Church in Australia - Adelaide October 2020. Appropriately the national themes for the Plenary Council were announced at Pentecost, June 2019. Why appropriately?

Because it was at Pentecost, the Jewish festival 50 days after the Passover when Jesus was crucified that the Holy Spirit came upon the apostles and inspired them to go forward, under the leadership of Peter, and establish the Catholic Church. (Acts 2. 1 – 15.) The National Centre for Pastoral Research, the executive preparing the plenary Council report, stated there were 222,000 people who participated in meetings and 17, 457 submissions. As reported earlier our parish was well and truly up there with 86 at the parish meeting and 151 submissions.

The six themes announced are very general and will require filling out. To many they will seem vague and not responsive to the submissions received. They are:

Missionary and evangelising

Inclusive, participatory and synodal

Prayerful and Eucharistic

Humble, healing and merciful

A joyful, hope filled and servant community

Open to conversion, renewal and reform

The website for the Council interestingly lists by headings the individual themes submitted by thousands of Catholics. These can be found on the website : https:// plenarycouncil.org.au

The website does not state the numbers in support of the various headings but the first six it lists under the heading" what people talked about" are: support for same-sex marriage

outreach to the wider community

servant leadership

allow contraception birth control

diocesan pastoral council

call to repentance for clergy sexual abuse

The next stage will involve the establishment of working groups for each of the six national themes.

A press release issued by the Archbishop of Perth, the chairman of the Council says: "people in faith communities across Australia will be called to Participate locally in their own communal listening and discernment encounters."

In coming months through the discernment process the agenda for the first session of the plenary Council will be developed.

This is clearly going to be a long process!!

Spiritual Direction being offered in our Parish.


In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.
