#### PLENARY COUNCIL

What an amazing parish!

When cut off day came, Ash Wednesday, for submissions to the 2020 plenary council we had a staggering 187 individual parishioners involved!

The original target was 80!

The quality of submissions was high, they were thoughtful and dedicated to the future renewal of the church.

The submissions broke down as follows:

86 participants at the parish gathering on 17 November 2018.

30 individual letters, many of several pages in length.

51 cards.

17 emails direct to the plenary council secretariat.

3 letters direct to the plenary council secretariat.

Every unit and group at the parish was involved and given the opportunity to discuss the purpose of the council and its potential for renewal.

On 12 March the plenary council secretariat confirmed receipt of all Terrigal parish submissions and further confirmed they would be submitted to the discernment process.

Over the next few months the secretariat will pull together the submissions from all over Australia and on the feast of Pentecost, Sunday

9 June 2019, the principal themes will be announced. Given the overwhelming support for certain key themes in Terrigal Parish I have no doubt they will be similar to those from the rest of Australia.

Terrigal principal themes:

Priests to be permitted to be married.

Women to be deacons( a number argued for priests).

A determined effort to win back the youth - a number of different ideas how to achieve this.

An acknowledgment of the clerical abuse of children and proposals to heal and help the victims.

Each of these was massively supported but there were some dissenting views on married priests. All views have gone forward.

The following also figured in many submissions:

Remarriage of divorced people. Permitting contraception. More outreach to the marginalised- especially lgbti people and refugees.

Laity involvement in church government.

There were also calls for liturgy to be made more relevant especially to the young/ more emphasis on the Holy Spirit and Mary.

Above all what came through repeatedly was a commitment to the church and its saving mission.
