From the Social Justice Terrigal Group:

On Care for our Common Home.

NO:1 These were written by Pope Francis on 24 May 2015. Pope Francis remind us of the canticle of St Francis of Assisi—that our common home is like a sister with whom we share our life and a beautiful mother who opens her arms to embrace us.

All welcome to join our group , we meet the 2nd Thursday of the month. Next meeting 12 September at 1pm. Abortion legislation. NSW Parliament.

Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you. (Jeremiah 1. 5).

Since 1971 abortion has been legal in NSW where a medical practitioner acting in good faith believes continuation of the pregnancy would jeopardise the physical or mental health of the mother.

The bill now before the NSW Parliament goes a lot further. It allows abortion on demand, without any reason, for the first 22 weeks of pregnancy. Thereafter it is allowed if 2 practitioners agree e.g. the referring doctor and the doctor at the abortion clinic. There are no safeguards. The criteria is vague- if there is concern for the persons "future physical mental or social circumstances". When asked what "social circumstances "meant the health Minister Brad Hazzard, the principal sponsor of this bill, was unable to reply. Effectively abortion on demand is legalised in New South Wales right up to the moment of birth.

Significantly the sponsors of the bill and the majority who supported them in the lower house refused to agree to amendments:

Requiring counselling in the 22 week period before an abortion.

Requiring the child welfare authorities be advised where a girl under 16 has an abortion

Prohibiting abortion in cases of gender selection (they agreed only to review in 12 months).

Requiring the baby born in cases of failed abortion be kept alive.

Pope John Paul II referred to abortion as" the culture of death". The Catholic Church has for centuries been unrelenting in its defence of unborn children. The catechism states: "this teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion... is gravely contrary to the moral law".

When the bill goes before the lower house of parliament, the legislative assembly, it is voted on by the whole house in the 2nd read and in the 3rd read. If it passes both readings it then goes to the upper house, the legislative Council

The member for Gosford, Liesl Tesch, voted for abortion on both the 2nd and the 3rd reading. The member for Terrigal, Adam Crouch, voted against abortion on the 2nd reading but voted for abortion on the 3rd reading.

The member for The Entrance, David Mehan, voted for abortion on both the 2nd and the 3rd reading.

The Bill now goes this week to the upper house, the Legislative Council. What will happen there is uncertain but it is believed the supporters of the bill are in the majority. While the bill is described as a private member's bill this is misleading as it has been enthusiastically supported by both Premier and the Health Minister, Brad Hazzard. To ensure speedy passage the standing orders were changed so that it could be debated in government time rather than private member's time. A bill which is debated only in private member's time can often take over a year before it even gets voted upon.

Those who oppose the abortion bill and uphold the Catholic Church teaching on the sanctity of the lives of unborn children are urged to write to the member of the Legislative Council who lives in this area,
