



#### Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

#### 24 June Mass at 9am

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus recalls Christ's love for us. Here are five facts that you may not know about this important feast of Our Lord. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus took centuries to become a universal celebration. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back to the 11th century. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque had multiple visions of the Sacred Heart between 1673 and 1675. However, it wasn't until 90 years later in 1765, that the feast was officially celebrated in France. In 1856, Pope Pius IX made the feast of the Sacred Heart into a universal celebration.

The first feast of the Sacred Heart was actually celebrated in 1670. Even before St. Margaret Mary Alacoque had her visions of the Sacred Heart there was a recorded celebration of this feast. St. Jean Eudes composed the first Office and Mass of the Sacred Heart. The first feast of the Sacred Heart was celebrated on Aug. 31, 1670 in Rennes, France. The feast takes place on the 19th day after Pentecost. The feast of the Sacred Heart is scheduled to be celebrated on the Friday after the octave (eighth day) of the feast of Corpus Christi. Corpus Christi is traditionally the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. However, in the United States, Corpus Christi is instead celebrated on the following Sunday. Despite this, the feast of the Sacred Heart still takes place 19 days after Pentecost. Jesus made 12 promises to those who honor the Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque:

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state in life.
- 2. I will establish peace in their families.
- 3. I will comfort them in their trials.
- 4. I will be their secure refuge during life, and, in death.
- 5. I will shed abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
- 6. Sinners will find in My Heart an infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Lukewarm souls will become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls will rapidly grow in holiness and perfection.
- 9. I will bless every place where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
- 10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. The names of those who promote this devotion will be written in My Heart, never to be blotted out.
- 12 . I promise thee, in the excessive mercy of My Heart, that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months, the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in my disgrace nor without receiving their Sacraments;

My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us.

#### Vox Populi - The Voice of the People -from the Broken Bay Diocese



The feast of Corpus Christi, also called the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, celebrates the institution of the Blessed Sacrament, or Holy Communion, and proclaims the truth of the transubstantiation of bread and wine into the actual body of Christ during Mass or the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Traditionally Corpus Christi has been celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday which this year would be Thursday 16 June. However not being a holy day of obligation it has been assigned to Sunday after the Most Holy Trinity, and so will be celebrated this Sunday 19 June.

The feast of Corpus Christi originated in 1246 when the Bishop of Liège (in present day Belgium) ordered the festival be celebrated in his Diocese after being persuaded by a young prioress who had experienced a vision. This woman, Juliana of Mount Cornillon, was officially recognised as a saint by Pope Pius IX in 1869.

The festival did not spread until Pope Urban IV ordered the whole Church to observe the feast. Shortly before Pope Urban issued his 1264 bull, St Thomas Aquinas had undertaken and completed the task of composing both the office, or official set of prayers for the Church, and the Mass for the feast. In some parts of the liturgy today Acquinas' work remains, in others it has been replaced. One hymn that has been excised but still remains well known, and performed, begins with the words Panis angelicus.

Pope Clement V proclaimed the feast universal and by the 15<sup>th</sup> century it had become one of the principal feasts in the Church.

Corpus Christi processions also became widespread and continue today where the consecrated host or Blessed Sacrament is displayed in a monstrance held aloft by a priest under a canopy, and followed by the faithful to the Church or Cathedral where there will be Benediction.

This Sunday everyone is invited to join the Walk With Christ Eucharistic Procession through the Sydney CBD. It begins at 2.30pm on the corner of Martin Place and Pitt Street, finishing at St Mary's Cathedral.


