Plenary Council Report.

The Church is now in the "listening and discernment" phase in preparation for the 2020 plenary Council.

What is discernment? The usual secular definition is "the ability to judge well."

In his third apostolic exhortation given in March 2018 Pope Francis saw it in the Catholic context as "seeking out and being inspired the Holy Spirit". To know what is God's will.

Working groups are to be appointed during the listening and discernment phase to develop the six themes announced at Pentecost.

The challenge is how to ensure that the concerns expressed by tens of thousands of Catholics are properly reflected in the agenda for the plenary Council. The six themes are vague and will need considerable development. It is important then that the working groups do not function in isolation but develop the agenda based on thousands of submissions and the concerns expressed by tens of thousands of laity.

It is also important that the bishops do not determine the agenda but rather they receive it. And consider it prayerfully. The bishops need guidance from the laity. The days when the bishops simply laid down the rules and the laity followed are well and truly over. The Pope in emphasising a new a new Synodal church has made it clear again and again that the laity are a crucial part in the future governance of the Church.

A recurrent theme of submissions for the plenary Council related to married priests. Initially Pope Francis appeared to be against this. This is no longer the case. The Pope has convened a Synod for bishops from the Amazon region (most South American countries). This will be in Rome in October 2019. He has specifically placed on the agenda the ordination of married men.

To quote:

"men ordained in remote areas should preferably be indigenous people respected and accepted by their community, **even if they already have a family...**"

As this Synod is to take place 12 months before our own plenary Council any decision on married priests, even if initially confined to South America, is an important precedent for Australia.

The shortage of priests in South America has become a massive crisis. Not millions but tens of millions have left the Catholic Church and gone over to Pentecostalism. As an Argentinian the Pope is well aware of this crisis and is now prepared to meet it head on. However, as always, he wishes to do this in a consultative and deliberative way. Hence the Synod.

The Australian bishops with the Pope in June this year. It was anticipated they would discuss with the Pope allowing the laity to have a deliberative vote at the plenary Council and not simply consultive role. No announcement has been made so far.

Future plenary Council reports will address the issue of the six themes.
