Unity, Hope and Light

On Thursday evening Bishop Anthony and other Christian leaders from the Diocese gathered with civic and religious leaders of the Jewish community to offer their support to our Jewish brothers and sisters and to express our opposition to the rising incidents of antisemitism in Australia.

As a concrete action that each of us can take, every Catholic home in the Broken Bay Diocese is asked to light a candle on Christmas Eve and put it in the window to be seen by all who pass by as a sign of unity, light and hope in the face of antisemitism. This symbolic action was chosen because this year Christmas Day and Chanukah (the Jewish festival of lights; see 1 Maccabees 4: 36-59) fall on the same day and this will not happen again for another hundred years.

Our Lady Star of the Sea Terrigal is committed to the care, wellbeing and protection of children, young people and vulnerable adults.

Elder Abuse Awareness

Alarming data released by the NSW Ageing and Disability Commission (ADC) shows a 38 per cent increase in statutory reports about the abuse of older people, with 53 per cent of these reports relating to allegations against adult children.

The data shows:

- 67 per cent of reports about abuse related to older women.
- Regional NSW accounted for half of reports, with the Central Coast as one of the most common areas.
- Adult Children (29 per cent) and paid workers (28 per cent) were the main reporters.

Signs of abuse can include the older person is no longer receiving the services they need to live, they are being prevented from speaking or seeing family, friends or grandchildren, or they cannot spend or access their own money.






