## 24 Hours for the Lord

The Holy Father, Pope Francis has invited us into a time of prayer and Reconciliation during Lent. In this Jubilee year, Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral will be available from **9am Friday 28<sup>th</sup> March to 9am Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> March**. During this time there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

## Chrism Mass

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at **7.30pm on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> April** at Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral.

## Lenten Program 6pm Friday in the parish of-fice immediately after Stations of the Cross.

The parable of the Prodigal Son is one of the best-known of all Jesus parables. Along with the parable of the Good Samaritan it is the most frequently quoted. The Gospels give us 30 parables; these are the two most popular. This week we examine the parable of the prodigal son. We go behind it to look at the story and what it actually means. We all understand it means God's forgiveness and mercy. But what about the other brother? Is it fair to him who worked and served the Father without complaint and without reward. Our God is a God of love, and is also the God of justice. Last week we examined the Transfiguration. We looked at the geography as to where it must have taken place and how it must have taken place. We examined the significance of Elijah and of Moses. There were many Old Testament prophets – why these two? Is it important? Yes, it is – because it deepens and enriches our knowledge of Jesus and of his work on earth. That is why Paul wrote the Epistles and why the Gospel writers wrote the Gospels. So that as St John says in his gospel: ....these things are written so that you might believe.... ( John 20.30). And as Jesus says: you shall learn the truth and the truth will make you free.( John 8.32).

## Second Rite of Reconciliation

will be celebrated in our parish at **7pm on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> April**. We will have a brief penitential liturgy which will include the act of contrition together; then each person will come to the priest and say: "I am sorry for ..." and the priest will pray the prayer of absolution: "I absolve you from your sins ... "; then we will say our penance together. The priest will be standing near the sanctuary and penitents will line up to confess. Unless we have large numbers attending, there will only be one priest. If you want a discussion with the priest, please come to the First Rite at the advertised times. All are welcome to attend.

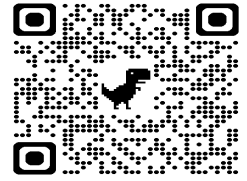

Many of you may be aware that a DA has been lodged to build a childcare centre for 113 children and 38 space carpark at 167 Serpentine Rd. This is the block behind the church with two houses, a horse and two cows. Central Coast Council has received a number of submissions expressing concerns, especially about traffic, stormwater and sewage. At the PPC meeting during the week it was agreed to engage professional consultants to assess our concerns and assist us in a way forward. We will keep you informed of any developments. ### Updating Parish Records

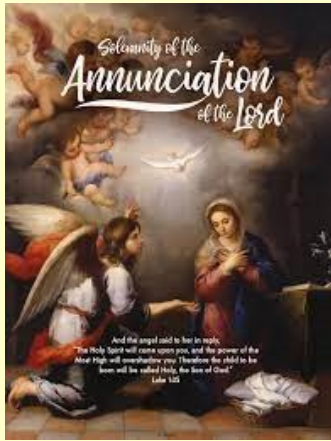
This weekend at all Masses – after the Prayer of the Faithful – we will be gathering information about parishioners (and those attending the Masses). We will be asking:


