**Plenary Council. 2020** Local Feedback—the large plurality of the submissions at the parish gathering and of the written submissions sent in thereafter favoured allowing priests to be married. Several submissions favoured continuation of the existing practice of celibacy.

The story of celibacy is an interesting one. It is a rule of the Church and not a teaching of the church. As such it can be changed by the Pope.

Quite a number of church rules have been changed as a result of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vatican Council or at the instigation in recent years of the Pope. Some examples are:

Permitting deceased Catholics to be cremated.

Permitting women to attend Mass without head coverings.

Permitting women to be Eucharistic ministers.

Allowing the laity to receive the chalice as well as the host at Holy Communion.

The Catholic Church has practised celibacy in the Western rite (the Latin rite) for around 1000 years.

The first written law was in 1139. In the early church clergy were married, including the Pope. St Peter the first Pope is recorded in St Matthew's Gospel as been married. (Matthew 8:14). The great majority of Australian Catholics are in the Western rite and so are accustomed to celibate priests. In the Eastern rite, including Eastern rite churches in Australia, married priests are permitted. Examples of Eastern rite churches are the Ukrainian, the Maronite and the Melkite.

In addition a number of married Anglican clergy have been re-ordained as Catholic priests in Australia. One of the best-known example is that of Father Fleming, a married priest who was the founder of Campion College at Toongabbie.

The Orthodox churches allow married priests. However neither the Eastern rite Catholic churches nor the Orthodox churches allow bishops to be married. The present Pope, Pope Francis, has made clear that he does not favour changing the rule in the Western rite to allow married priests. Pope John Paul described celibacy as the" jewel of the priesthood."

The National Council of priests, the organisation representing all priests in Australia has placed the issue of celibacy as a subject to be debated at the plenary Council.

The bishops of Australia, in their response to the Royal commission on sexual abuse, agreed to forward the Royal commission's recommendation that the celibacy rule be abolished to the Vatican for consideration. This did not mean they endorsed it but it did mean that they considered worthy of being addressed. They rejected the royal commission recommendation that the secrecy of the confession be breached in child abuse cases as inconsistent with Catholic teaching. Any change to the rule would affect the entire Western rite, so even if endorsed by the Plenary Council, would require a change of heart by the Pope.


