

Abortion legislation 2019 NSW Parliament

"People should take a moment to consider why abortion is the only medical procedure that requires its own act of Parliament... The reason is that it is the only medical procedure that seeks not to save or improve a life, but to end a life."

(Taylor Martin MLC, Central Coast based member of the NSW upper house, speaking against the abortion legislation this week.)

In their rush to achieve abortion on demand in NSW the Premier, Gladys Berijiklian and the health minister, Brad Hazzard have overlooked the fundamental principle of medicine enunciated over 2000 years ago by Hippocrates: first do no harm.

On Wednesday night, just past, the NSW upper house, the Legislative Council, by 26 to 15 voted for the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the abortion legislation. The only member of the upper house to live on the Central Coast, Taylor Martin, strongly opposed the legislation and voted against it. In an attempt to appease unrest in her own party, the majority of whom in both houses voted against the legislation, the Premier has agreed to defer a final vote for 4 weeks.

# A petition from this parish containing 237 signatures was tabled by Taylor Martin before the debate began.

It is impossible to overestimate the abhorrence of this legislation. It is presented, in an oversimplification, as a woman's right to choose but every speaker in favour of the legislation, without exception, carefully avoids acknowledging this necessitates the deliberate killing of the unborn child.

For example an amendment requiring that babies who are born alive after an abortion are given medical care rather than being left to die was refused. This is tragically not uncommon. Statistics from Queensland released by the health minister in 2016 show that no less than 204 babies between 2005 and 2015 were left to die after botched abortions!

The Minister for Corrective Services, Anthony Roberts, speaking against the legislation pointed out that in 1955 NSW abolished the death penalty for convicted murderers. In 2019 the proponents of this legislation are reintroducing it for the crime of being inconvenient.

Another example of its abhorrence is that it allows abortion for sex selection. Statistics from Victoria show an abnormal number of male births over female births in the Indian and Chinese communities since similar legislation was passed in that state.

Over the next 4 weeks members of the upper house will be invited to examine series of amendments and also the report by the Council committee. Hopefully some of these will improve the legislation.
