Animator's Report

**Calling all Catholics
Your church wants to hear your voice
Plenary council 2020**

Calling all Catholics.**Your Church wants to hear your voice..**

Last Saturday, 17 November, was a unique day in the life of our Parish.

For the first time parishioners came together to freely talk about the Church, to share views and stories, to critique what the Church does well and to look at solutions to the many challenges the Church faces in present day Australia. 86 parishioners attended. The discussion, though vigorous, was respectful and positive.

All views will go forward to the Diocese. There are no right nor wrong views.

Some of the most discussed views were:

Celibacy of the clergy.

While many supported this being made voluntary concerns were expressed about issues such as the parish reorganisation it would require in accommodation for families, payment of priests and what happens when priestly marriages break down.

Catholic Schools.

The consensus was that while these provide high quality education, there was a strong concern that they are unhappily failing in their core mission of imparting the faith.

Role of women in the Church.

There was widespread support for the Pope's commission investigating the opening of the diaconate to women. A number of parishioners also called for a reassessment of opening the priesthood to women.

Past abuse of children.

There was a strong desire to support the victims of abuse through apology and acknowledgement of wrongdoing but also in practical ways by counselling and compensation. Especially strong was the determination that this must never again be covered up or allowed to happen.

Outreach to youth

Suggestions included a revival of an organised youth program similar to the former CYO.

Others suggested a close examination and, where possible, a replication of the successful youth programs run by the EV and Pentecostal Churches.

Your views.
