Joseph House | House of Discernment for Men Applications 2025 Now Open!

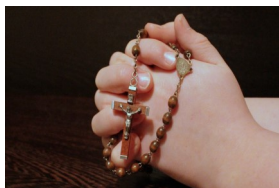

Men's Bushwalking Group

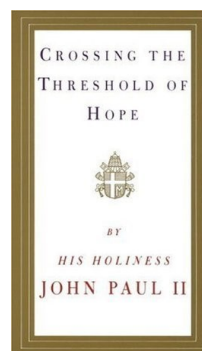

We have **two regular collections** in the parish
each weekend.

All other **special collections** go to the charity
or activity that is advertised when we have the
appeal.

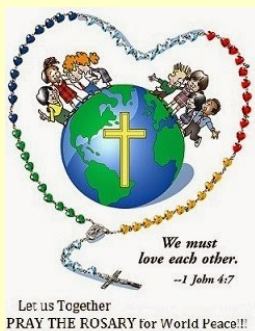
Praying for Peace in the World

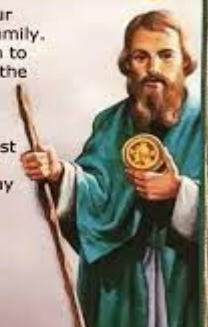
