World Youth Day Pilgrims in Panama!

Please keep our 65 Broken Bay pilgrims in your prayers as they join with more than 1,000 Australians in Panama City for World Youth Day. **Photos on the notice board.**

In his address, Sydney Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP said: "We come together this week, young people with their lay leaders, pastors, and pope as a living-breathing, singing-dancing, praying-acting proof that the Catholic Church is alive and well."

Canberra and Goulburn Archbishop Christopher Prowse encouraged the young Catholics gathered to remember the three L's: the lost, the last and the least.

The group then walked through the hot midday sun to Cinta Costera Square for the opening Mass.

Broken Bay Diocese Deacon Adrian Gomez, writing on his WYD blog, explored the many surprising experiences of taking part in the pilgrimage, linking the challenges of the journey with the growth and change that happen in one's spiritual life. Deacon Gomez wrote: "Discomfort is part of the pilgrimage experience. In the spiritual life, when growth and change happen, there can be discomfort and pain. When we exercise for the first few times, there is a feeling of pain. But as our bodies are strengthened over time, the pain lessens."

In all, more than 1000 Australians have made the journey to Panama. Official WYD figures suggest numbers will exceed 100,000 travellers from 156 countries.

More than 20,000 local volunteers and almost 2500 international volunteers are supporting the event, with 2500 journalists. Pope Francis will preside at several events during the final four days of World Youth Day, including the Way of the Cross on Friday and the final Mass on Sunday.

Supporting the PNG MISSIONS through the works of the Michaelite Mission Priests. At Terrigal we have been supported by the Michaelite priests since 2002. This is a special way of giving back to them through their Missions

Priests working in PNG receive little financial assistance and often have to work in difficult conditions.

CCD Ministry Induction (CCDMI) Course

- The CCD Ministry Induction course (8 units) is compulsory for all new CCD catechists and those catechists returning to teach after an extended break from teaching.
- The CCDMI can be completed online, except for '*Teaching the Authorised Curriculum*', which is required to be completed 'face to face'. The website is currently being updated, but should be back online soon.
- **Important:** New CCD catechists will **not** be issued with their Provisional cards (*and therefore not permitted to enter a classroom*) unless they have completed this training.
- However, it is imperative that all catechists complete the Safeguarding Children session as soon as possible, whether as part of their CCDMI or ongoing mandatory training.
