Animator's Report Calling all Catholics. Your church wants to hear your voice. Plenary council 2020.

Catholic Education in Australia is, in one sense, an extraordinary success story.

The statistics are impressive. 1,700 schools, 750.000 students, 60,000 teachers.

Effectively one in five children in Australia are at a Catholic school. In addition

at a tertiary level there are two Catholic Universities and the country's only liberal arts college.

For over 100 years this vast system was built without any Government assistance and staffed by the lifelong self sacrifice of thousands of women and men in the religious orders.

Catholic schools rightly enjoy a reputation for high academic and sporting achievement.

Few other English speaking countries have such a proud record. (In the United States the number of students at Catholic schools 40 years ago was 5 million; now it is only 2 million. In recent years over 1900 schools have closed.)

Yet one frightening statistic casts a dark shadow: 95% of all graduates of Catholic education have no involvement with the Church after leaving school. Why? These figures tell their own story. How can a system be achieving the propagation of the Catholic faith if only one in twenty graduates choose to follow that faith? Again, a major challenge to be addressed at the Plenary Council.

In 2006 the Bishops issued a pastoral statement : Catholic Schools at the Crossroads.

They identified this failure but had no solution to resolve it

Can it be resolved? Are we destined to follow the American decline?

What are your views? How can our schools become once again "fortresses of faith"?

How do we make sure "Catholic education" is Catholic? Isn't that an enormous challenge for the 21st century Church?

He was a devout Catholic, living at Potts Point and a generous benefactor of St Mary's Cathedral.




