Animator's Report

Calling all Catholics
Your church wants to hear your voice
Plenary council 2020

Calling all Catholics. Your Church wants to hear your voice.

On Saturday 24 November a Diocesan Assembly was held at Hornsby as part of preparation for the Plenary Council.

2018 is the year of consultation and survey.

2019 is to be the year of discernment.

This will then lead into the final year of preparation for the Council and the holding of its first meeting in Adelaide in October 2020.A second session of the Council will take place in May 2021.

The Council will consist of:

43 Bishops.

100 male clerics (priests and religious).

100 female clerics (religious).

100 laity (men and women).

The Archbishop of Perth, Tim Costello, will chair. All delegates will have a say - a consultative vote- but only the Bishops will determine the final submissions, what is called a deliberative vote.

Discussions are reportedly underway with Rome as to whether all delegate, not just Bishops, can have a deliberative vote. The Bishops of Australia are to meet the Pope in Rome in June 2019.

The Pope showed he is open to widening deliberations at the recent World Youth Synod in Rome when, for the first time ever, he allowed male religious to vote on the deliberations instead of confining it to the Bishops.

Canon Law does limit voting to Bishops but the Pope can grant a dispensation if he is so minded. There was strong feeling at the Assembly that the Church in Australia needs to move beyond the sole control of the Bishops. The convenor stated:

"the future lies in a live, active, lay led church".

On a positive note, Terrigal Parish is well advanced in its preparations. As far as could be ascertained no other parish has so far held a parish gathering similar to one held at Terrigal on 17 November.




