### PLENARY COUNCIL

Participation in preparing for the Plenary Council in our parish has been outstanding. 86 parishioners attended the Parish gathering. 20 have made written submissions in letters. 18 have made written submissions on the Plenary Council cards.

A total of 124. In addition a number of parents participated through the school, as did the teachers. Some parishioners have sent their submissions direct to the Council at PO Box 747 North Sydney NSW 2059.

A summary of the principal submissions will be published in the Bulletin, after the cut off date, Ash Wednesday. (6 March).

There is still time for parishioners who have not participated to do so. Cards are available at the table at the back of the Church as is a box for completed cards. Everyone's views are sought, all are respected and all will go forward. Naturally there is a range of views but what is significant is the commitment to Church renewal.

Once the submission stage is concluded the various nationwide submissions will be collated and on Pentecost (Sunday 9 June) the principal themes will be announced.

A special secretariat has been established for this purpose.

Renewal is crucial for all organisations, the Church included. After the Protestant Reformation the Church renewed itself through the reforms instituted by the Council of Trent. The Plenary Council in Australia is part of a world wide renewal of the Church as it faces the challenges of the 21st century.

The Pope calls all Catholics to renew in what he calls a Synodal Church- a church where all are listened to and engaged.

The Council theme is: Listen to what the Spirit is saying to the Churches.

We are all called to give our reply.
