Chrism Mass

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated at **7.30pm on Tuesday 15th April** at Our Lady of the Rosary Cathedral, Waitara.

Lenten Program 6pm Friday in the parish office immediately after Stations of the Cross.

The 40 days of Lent continue. So does our Lenten study. As Catholics we are preparing for the greatest event in human history – the Resurrection of our Divine Saviour Jesus Christ. As the apostle Paul puts it: "if Christ be not risen then we witness in vain". (1 Corinthians 15:14). Last week we examined the story of the Prodigal Son. More correctly the Lost Son as the parable is actually one of a trilogy of three – the lost sheep, the lost coin & finally the lost son. We looked not only at those 3 parables but also we examined the role of the older brother. He had a justified complaint. Didn't he work hard all his life and where was his reward? The complaint is echoed in the very interesting story of the Labourers of the Vineyard. Was it fair that they all got the same amount even though they worked different hours? This week we progress further and examine the famous story of the woman caught in adultery. "Let him who is without sin cast the first stone" – how well do we know these words but what do they mean? Does it mean that all crimes/offences should go unpunished because we are all sinners? Significantly the woman is allowed to go her way even without making any act of repentance or acknowledgement of Jesus. The Good Thief on the Cross, promised paradise after a life of sin, did acknowledge Jesus. What does all this mean? Come along. Together we seek to understand.

Second Rite of Reconciliation

will be celebrated in our parish at **7pm on Thursday 10th April**. We will have a brief penitential liturgy which will include the act of contrition together; then each person will come to the priest and say: "I am sorry for ... " and the priest will pray the prayer of absolution: "I absolve you from your sins ... "; then we will say our penance together. The priest will be standing near the sanctuary and penitents will line up to confess. Unless we have large numbers attending, there will only be one priest. If you want a discussion with the priest, please come to the First Rite at the advertised times. All are welcome to attend. For more information go to:

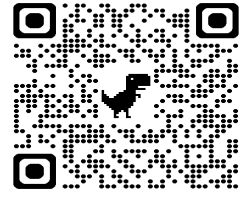

Many of you may be aware that a DA has been lodged to build a childcare centre for 113 children and 38 space carpark at 167 Serpentine Rd. This is the block behind the church with two houses, a horse and two cows. Central Coast Council has received a number of submissions expressing concerns, especially about traffic, stormwater and sewage. At the PPC meeting during the week it was agreed to engage professional consultants to assess our concerns and assist us in a way forward. We will keep you informed of any developments. 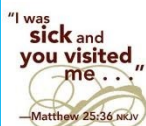

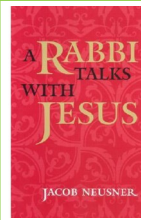

Book Club For the book club meeting on April 25th at 1600hrs in the parish offices we will be discussing Jacob Neusner's book "A Rabbi Talks with Jesus". Neusner imagines being present at the sermon of the mount and wonders if he would have followed Jesus (using the criteria of the Torah of Moses), or held on to his own beliefs and walked away.
