

Calling all Catholics: Animators Report

Your Church wants to hear your voice. Plenary Council 2020. Listen to what the Spirit is saying...(Revelations 2:7). 86 parishioners attended the Parish Gathering on 17 November telling their faith stories and expressing their views. In addition a further 15 parishioners, unable to attend the gathering, have put pen to paper and written their individual submissions.

All submissions, from the gathering and personally submitted are being collated and will be forwarded after the cut of date, Ash Wednesday 2019 (6 March) to the Diocesan team for further collation and presentation to the Council. Any one who wishes to still make a submission can still do so. There is still time. Simply put your story or views in a sealed envelope marked" Plenary Council" and place on the collection plate at Mass or hand in to the parish office. Alternatively they can be posted direct to PO Box 747 North Sydney NSW 2059. 2019 is designated as the year of discernment. Our parish will have, towards the end of the year, a meeting to receive a report on the submissions and a further opportunity for discussion.

After Ash Wednesday 2019 a parish report will be made through the Bulletin on the views expressed by our parishioners. There are no right or wrong views- all will go forward. Some interesting views so far:

An app to explain and follow the Mass. Given the attention many people especially young people give to iPhones this could be helpful.

Greater use of Liturgy of the Word with modern music/bands for youth services.

Many have commented how their children and grandchildren find the Mass unfulfilling or boring.

These two proposals could help address this. In addition three themes predominate: Priestly celibacy- make it voluntary The role of women- increase and enhance it. Youth education and involvement- make the Church relevant and impart the faith.

The scriptural theme for the Council is from Revelation Chapter 2 -To the Church in Ephesus.

Though written 2000 years ago its' message still echoes today.

"Whoever has ears let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To the one who is victorious, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God."

Last Days of Advent

St. Pope John Paul II, Dec. 18, 2002

Pope John Paul II in his address on Dec. 18, 2002 said, "The liturgy of Advent...helps us to understand fully the value and meaning of the mystery of Christmas. It is not just about commemorating the historical event, which occurred some 2,000 years ago in a little village of Judea. Instead, it is necessary to understand that the whole of our life must be an 'advent,' a vigilant awaiting of the final coming of Christ. To predispose our mind to welcome the Lord who, as we say in the Creed, one day will come to judge the living and the dead, we must learn to recognize him as present in the events of daily life. Therefore, Advent is, so to speak, an intense training that directs us decisively toward him who already came, who will come, and who comes continuously."
