A Year of Discernment 2019

DIVINE RENOVATION RENOVATION A national Divine Renovation forum,

titled Leading your Parish from

Maintenance to Mission, is taking place in Sydney this August. It is an opportunity for those involved in the movement of parishes from maintenance to mission to gather and actively learn from others already active in the process.

The book Divine Renovation, by Fr James Mallon, identified challenges faced by parishes and highlighted the need for a new vision and a way forward for parishes to be renewed with a focus on evangelisation, leadership and discipleship. Many parishes around the world have learnt from this vision and implemented strategies to transform their parishes into dynamic parishes of missionary disciples.

This 3-day workshop will discuss key implementation issues with a particular focus on leadership, small group culture and parish strategies for going forward and will allow for sharing of experiences and questions. Speakers and facilitators will include Fr James Mallon and Rob McDowell via Skype, as well as Bishop Ric Thorpe of the Anglican Diocese of London, Daniel Ang and others from around Australia who form part of the Divine Renovation Network.

Peter's Pence Appeal 7 July 2019

By supporting this collection, you join with other Parishes across the world in supporting projects identified by the Pope including emergency assistance to those in need due to natural disaster, war, oppression and disease. Our generosity allows the Holy Father to respond to those suffering with love and compassion. Thank you for your generosity.

Donations using funds from the Peter's Pence appeal have assisted with these recent natural disasters including: The Indonesian island of Sulawesi affected by the earthquake

and tsunami

Between September and October 2018 violent earthquakes and a strong tsunami devastated several areas of Indonesia causing over 1,500 dead and thousands injured. The area most affected was the island of Sulawesi where the Mount Soputan volcano erupted threatening the already exhausted and worn out population.

In the first phase of emergency, Pope Francis, through the Department for the Integral Human Development Service, sent a contribution of **\$100,000** that will be distributed, in collaboration with the Apostolic Nunciature, among the areas most affected by the catastrophe.

During the Angelus of Sunday, 30 September, 2018 the Holy Father prayed for those affected, "for the deceased,

unfortunately many, for the injured and for those who have lost their homes and their jobs. May the Lord console them and support the efforts of those who are trying to bring help".

There will be a collection at the end of all Masses.

I must say that I felt welcome from my first day and hope that you can find in me a person you can approach. As I said at my first weekend in the parish, my door is always open for assistance or a discussion. Thanks to those who have done so.

I believe we have some challenges to achieve. Our growth in the Catholic Faith is paramount. To deepen our relationship with Our Lord is not an optional extra, but essential to a closer relationship with him and each other. 
The 2019/2020 weekly envelopes are now ready for collection and will be left in the church foyers.
