 - new people and community need many conversion points and stimulate the desire to stay i.e. the different types of ministries
 - new people should be encouraged and their talents harnessed to assist with youth
 - there is a shortage of altar servers and catechists
 - during Co-vid people found other ways to experience the Church
 - the positivity of music and the use of this as a resource
 - the Church is not just the priest
