Our much loved former Assistant Priest Fr Barry Nobbs died peacefully last Friday after a year of ill health.

We will be celebrating a Funeral Vigil Mass here at Our Lady of Dolours Chatswood on Monday 2 December at 7.30pm.

His Mass of Christian Burial will be at St Felix Church, 550 Chapel Rd, Bankstown on Tuesday 3 December at 11.00am.

Vigil for Fr Barry: We are honoured to host this diocesan Vigil Mass for Fr Barry on Monday night. We anticipate a significant crowd with people coming from several parishes where Fr Barry has ministered. We are seeking the generous hospitality of the parish in two ways. Firstly, to provide supper after the liturgy. If you could provide a plate of sandwiches, savouries, cakes, slices or fruit, could you please take one of the plastic trays from the foyer of the church this weekend, and bring it with you to the liturgy on Monday night. Secondly, we are seeking donations of white and yellow flowers for the altar. If you could please bring these flowers to the church by 2pm on Sunday our volunteers will be able to arrange them.

Christmas ministries: Liturgical ministry leaders are already contacting people to do the ministries of the Word, Music, Communion and Altar service for our six Christmas Masses. There are many other ministries we need help with also: Welcomers, Wardens (money collectors), First Aid Officers (with a current First Aid qualification) and Parking attendants (at the 5.3opm vigil). We will be asking for your help next weekend – please think about which Mass you will come to for Christmas and in what way you can help.

Reconciliation: The season of Advent is a time when many people approach the sacrament of Reconciliation. In addition to our usual weekly time of Thursday 7pm & Saturday 9.30am, during December there will also be Reconciliation available at 12.45pm Mondays and 9.30am Fridays.

Christmas Invitations: Christmas is the Church's greatest time of outreach, and we invite you to be part of this opportunity. We have printed 7500 Christmas cards inviting people to join us for Christmas Mass which we will deliver to hopefully every household in the parish. Starting next weekend on the 8th December, we invite you to simply take a bunch of cards and cross the street, to which you will deliver, off the list. Note that we can only deliver within the parish's official boundary. Deliver to your own street, or to a street near you to get some Advent exercise! The postcards and list of streets will be located in the church foyer on the weekends of the 8th and 15th December.

Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act* 2012.
