REMEMBRANCE MASS

Yet, many people have not had the opportunity to fully grieve for their child, especially in years past when the advice given to parents who suffered miscarriage and stillbirth was just to "move on, try again, forget about it". **This Monday Nov 12th at 7.30pm** Fr Jim will celebrate a special **Mass of Remembrance for children** who have died, at any age, through accident, illness, suicide, miscarriage, abortion or stillbirth. AN INVITATION TO SPEND A LITTLE TIME WITH THE PROPHETS OF ADVENT

Advent can be such a busy time that it can slip away without the opportunity to really engage with the wonderful readings that are offered to us from the Hebrew prophets. Their rich and colourful language paints such vivid pictures of God's promises to us.

The prophet Isaiah continued to be read in the synagogues during Jesus' lifetime and was proclaimed by Jesus at the beginning of his public ministry (*Luke 4: 16-20*). The weekday readings in this Advent are largely drawn from Isaiah while the Sunday readings include the prophets Jeremiah, Baruch, Zephaniah and Micah.

These sessions will include something of the world of the prophets, what is known about them and time to pray with some of their writings.

Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry.
