Reconciliation times: From next week we will move Sunday morning Reconciliation to Thursday nights, 7pm -8pm. This gives a longer, unhurried time for the sacrament to be experienced, equally available to all parishioners, not just those who attend Sunday morning Mass. The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration in this time. Reconciliation will continue to be offered from 9.30am to 10.30am on Saturdays. Fr Jim and Fr John also welcome people making appointments to celebrate Reconciliation at other times.

Anointing of the Sick: Anointing of the Sick will be offered after the 12.15pm Mass on the third Thursday of each month, Thursday July 18th and following. Fr John and Fr Jim regularly anoint people in each of the 8 aged care centres in our parish and those who receive Communion at home. They welcome people making appointments for the sacrament whenever it is needed due to illness, surgery or diagnosis of serious sickness.

First Spiritual Exercises: Using the creative guide to St Ignatius' First Spiritual Exercises, written by Fr Michael Hansen SJ, these sessions offer the experience of a four week retreat in daily life. Cost of the book is \$30. Each group will be limited to 12 participants. Fr Jim McKeon, Gail Gill and Sam French (seminarian) will facilitate the groups.

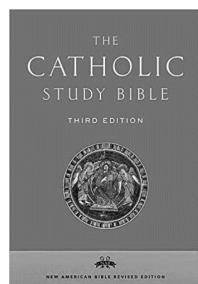

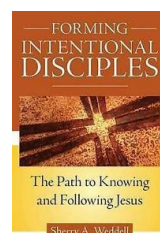

Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry.
