PARISH FEAST DAY

An invitation to give: This weekend we are celebrating our Parish Feast Day, and at each Mass you'll see a short video of parishioners sharing what they like about our parish – there is much to celebrate! We also want to tell you about our plans for the year ahead and how you can help by supporting the parish financially.

In 2019 - 2020 we hope to

- install new, specialised speakers which can overcome the reverberation in our church which has large flat surfaces and a dome which causes reverberation and reduces sound clarity (\$100,000)
- Start Community Dinners every Saturday night from October (\$10,000 per year)
- Run the Alpha program in March 2020, and other pastoral programs next year (\$10,000)
- Employ a new staff member to be a *small groups co-ordinator*. We have so many new people approaching the parish that we now need to be able to facilitate their ongoing involvement in the parish (\$36,000 per year)
- Build a new baptism font on the sanctuary in stone to match altar (\$10,000)
- Offer a Ministry Scholarship to a university student to engage them in a range of parish ministries (\$15,000)
- continue all existing parish ministries
- rectify cracks in the church walls

- a) authorise the parish to deduct a donation from your nominated credit card (a weekly amount, deducted monthly)
- b) arrange a direct debit from your bank account to the parish account Chatswood Parish (Our Lady of Dolours) BSB 062-784, account # 1073 8005, using "PG" & your name as the reference. This can be at your preferred frequency (weekly / fortnightly / monthly)
- c) pledge a weekly amount and receive envelopes (for privacy) to make cash donations each week.

Our hope is that everyone who considers Our Lady of Dolours to be their parish will be a committed giver in one of these three ways. If you are not yet, giving, please consider giving as an expression of your commitment. If you are already giving, this is an opportunity to change the amount or the way you give.

OUTDOOR ROSARY



PREPARATION FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNION



This week the children preparing for First Holy Communion have been attending one of the seven two hour retreat sessions available to them.

During the retreat we have been focusing on the Liturgy of the Eucharist, in particular we have been thinking and wondering about the prayers and gestures (actions) made by the priest when he asks God to send the Holy Spirit into the bread and wine, so that they become "The Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ".



SHERRY WEDDELL gives us interesting insights with regard to being Catholic today. Her extensive research reveals that most Catholics have a long way to go towards becoming an intentional disciple of Jesus Christ. In fact, most people who attend Mass are still at the first threshold of "trust" and may not see their faith as a relationship with Jesus at all. The good news, though, is that 5.3 million Australians still identify as Catholic, with the vast majority being potential disciples.

Sherry shares effective strategies for parishes to encourage movement from one threshold to the next. This movement allows us to increase the number of people who develop a personal relationship with Jesus and make the decision to follow him intentionally. It is through growth in our people that our parishes will grow and thrive.

This is an important conversation for our times and for our Diocese that will give us the strategies we need to be effective in our work of forming missionary disciples today to renew our parishes.

Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act* 2012.
