Fr Andrew Kim will be leaving our parish at the end of the month. He has been appointed as full-time chaplain to Royal North Shore Hospital and will reside at Northbridge. We will be farewelling him after the 9am Mass on June 23rd. We apologise for the inconvenience which this change will cause. Please let other weekday Mass goers know of this change so that they are not caught out. If you wish to attend a local morning mass on a Monday, St Thomas' has a 9am mass and Lindfield-Killara has a 9.15am.

Book Club: Fr Jim would like to invite people into a discussion about some of the contributing factors which have allowed sexual abuse both to take place and to be covered up within the Church. This will be done through the lens of a book club reading bishop Geoffrey Robinson's book “For Christ's Sake”. There will be two groups meeting on 6 Monday nights from June 17 or 6 Thursday nights from June 20th. Please put your name on the list in the foyer. If you have already put your name down in the past week a copy of the book will be available for you to pick up this weekend.

Community Dinners: We are launching a new project, a free, weekly “Community Dinners” which will be open to anyone who wants to share a meal in good company, Catholic and non-Catholic alike. We are looking for volunteers willing to commit to cook and serve on one Saturday night each month. We will form 4 teams who will each cook and serve once each month, so that no one is overly burdened.

We will have a launch meeting to meet one another, create teams, and answer questions on Saturday June 29th 6.30pm the parish hall (Harrington Hall, across the OLD school yard). At this meeting we will determine if we have sufficient volunteers to go forward and to launch the dinners in September. Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012*.
