Hot days: As we move into summer, we will have some hot days where even in the morning it is hotter outside the church than in. On these days it is best to leave the windows and internal doors of the church closed to keep the heat out as long as possible, as the church can stay quite cool. If a cool breeze comes through in the afternoon then the church can be opened up to allow the cooler air to flow through. If you are opening or closing the upper windows which are pulley operated please be gentle with the ropes – there is no need to wrap them tightly as this breaks the ropes in time.

Year 6 Mass: Every 9am Mass is a parish family Mass where we welcome and encourage the involvement of families with young children, and on the third week of each month we encourage a different year group to take a special part. Next Sunday, Nov 24th will be an additional special Mass for Year 6 from all schools, with Bishop Anthony Randazzo presiding.

All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry.
