**Congratulations to Bishop David** who celebrates his 80<sup>th</sup> birthday this week, which also marks 5 years that he has been assisting our parish in his retirement. You may like to sign the card in the foyer, and join us for morning tea on the forecourt after the 10.30am Mass today.

Liturgy Committee: The Liturgy Committee had its final meeting for the year last week. Plans for the Christmas liturgies are now well underway. Three members of the committee: Judith Ryan, John Paul Maiorana and Victoria Tubier have now stepped down from the committee and we thank them for their significant years of service to the parish. Four members; Gerard Ryan, Laura Pereira, Charmaine Wan and Bianca Zatz will continue on the committee for 2019. We will be seeking three or four more people to join the Liturgy Committee in 2019 to assist the clergy to prepare our major liturgies and to refine our overall liturgical practice. We will be seeking people with a range of skills and backgrounds, ages, people who are long-term parishioners who hold the memory of the parish, and people new to the parish who bring fresh new ideas.

Charitable Works Fund: This weekend we invite you to give to the Charitable Works Fund which supports our Catechists in State Schools and our Catholic chaplains in public hospitals. You can make a donation in the envelopes on the seats in the church, and these can be placed on either the first or second collection baskets, which avoids us needing to take a separate third collection. We take this opportunity to inform you of some other upcoming collections: the St Vincent de Paul Christmas Appeal and possibly a collection to assist flood ravaged areas of India in December, a collection on Christmas Day to support our three social justice projects, and the Catholic Mission annual appeal in January.

#### **CATECHIST CO-ORDINATOR**

## AN INVITATION TO SPEND A LITTLE TIME WITH THE PROPHETS OF ADVENT

Advent can be such a busy time that it can slip away without the opportunity to really engage with the wonderful readings that are offered to us from the Hebrew prophets. Their rich and colourful language paints such vivid pictures of God's promises to us.

The prophet Isaiah continued to be read in the synagogues during Jesus' lifetime and was proclaimed by Jesus at the beginning of his public ministry (*Luke 4: 16-20*). The weekday readings in this Advent are largely drawn from Isaiah while the Sunday readings include the prophets Jeremiah, Baruch, Zephaniah and Micah.

These sessions will include something of the world of the prophets, what is known about them and time to pray with some of their writings.

#### Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act* 2012.
