UPDATE FROM THE PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL TUESDAY 14 MAY 2019

This week, the fourth Parish Pastoral Council meeting this year, we revisited and reflected upon how intentional disciples of Jesus are formed. Reflecting and sharing our own faith journey, we appreciated hearing faith experiences other than our own, and could identify similarities and differences in our own ongoing conversion. This led us to explore pathways that are more likely to help parishioners deepen their relationship with Jesus. We discussed what has worked well in achieving this deepening of faith in our own parish in the past, along with successful models and programmes in other parishes in our diocese and dioceses further afield. Initiatives, such as faith sharing groups that have been fruitful appear to include the five elements: Give, Connect, Worship, Grow, Serve. Other themes that emerged following reflection were the power of small groups, the desire to build trust, the need for space and time to share and build relationships. This discernment will help us formulate the next steps towards our focus for the year - supporting individuals in the parish to deepen their personal relationship with God. Parish Pastoral Council

Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act* 2012.
