Sunday night Communion Ministers: Another change to Sunday nights without Adrian Brannan is that we need a more effective way of ensuring that we have the correct number of Communion Ministers. From the start of the new roster in February we will no longer have a roster for Communion Ministers of Sunday nights. Instead, wooden crosses corresponding the number of Communion Ministers needed will be on the offertory table in the middle of the church. We invite trained and commissioned Communion Ministers to take and wear a cross so that we have clarity about who will be giving Communion, and only those people wearing a cross to come forward.
