The Second Reading: From now until the beginning of Lent in March we are reading from the final five chapters of St Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians at Sunday Mass. Fr Jim will be preaching on these chapters each week as we hear the central gospel message, some controversies and their solutions over the coming seven weeks. You'll hear some very familiar and popular passages, as well as some challenging ones. There are actually just three chapters; 12, 13 and 15 which we will be exploring in depth. Why these chapters? Why are chapters 14 and 16 not included in the lectionary? What is omitted, as well as what is included can be instructive. Take the time to read through these chapters, and to listen as they are proclaimed by our Ministers of the Word each week.

Corinthians: This week we hear St Paul describe the charisms which were being expressed in Christian worship at the time such as prophecy and speaking in tongues. Today we would call these "liturgical ministries" while they look quite different to those of first century worship, they are as Paul says "moved by the same Spirit". The most common liturgical ministries today are Ministers of the Word, Ministers at the Altar (Altar Servers, both senior and junior), Music Ministers and Special Ministers of Communion. New ministries are also emerging such as welcomers, wardens and audio-visual operators. Is the Holy Spirit inviting you to contribute some liturgical ministry? Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry.
