

Placement of New Font: As you are aware once we moved the old Baptismal font from out of the main aisle, we placed the portable font on the lower level of the sanctuary down from the Presider's chair. It was always our intention to try different situations so that parishioners can see what it looks like and give their opinion. At out Liturgy Team meeting on Tuesday 16th July we decided to trial other spots so people can see what may be the best solution for the new font. As of this weekend the font will be below the Ambo (where the readings are made from). We will leave it there for a couple of weeks and then try another position.

The Church does not designate where a font should be placed but does state that there should be a relationship between the Font, the Ambo and the Altar. The Font is our entry into the Church which leads to us hearing the Word of God from the Ambo and thus to receiving the Lord from the Altar at Communion.

Once we have trialed other spots, we will have photos of each situation in the foyer and you will be asked to nominated which position you feel is the best. Once we have agreed upon the right position, we will be able to look at designs. We will keep you informed at all times so you are aware what stage we are at. 

Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act* 2012.
