**Name tags**: For some time now, the Pastoral Council has been promoting "Name Tag" Sundays at the beginning of each month to encourage everyone to get to know and call each other by name. This initiative has been successful and made a difference in how we interact and relate to each other. **Carpark safety:** Last weekend during the parish feast day celebrations there was an incident in the parish carpark / school playground which led to one person being injured and several cars being damaged. A car was out of control at significant speed and the injuries could have been much more severe. This incident has been a wake-up call for us to re-look at how the shared car and pedestrian space is used on weekends. Already we have been keeping cars back from the area near the play equipment at the monthly school grade Mass when there are children playing in the area. We ask you to take extra care both when driving and walking around the grounds. Parents, please supervise your children at all times.

Our new parish Finance & Facilities Officer, Michael Mercer has already engaged a traffic management consultant to look at how vehicles and pedestrians use our site. There will need to be some changes to how we use the site in order to prevent future accidents. One change which will begin next week is that the Archer St carpark entrance next to the church will be shut from 9am to 9.30am due to the children crossing from the church to the school for children's liturgy at this time. If you are running late and arrive after 9am, do not enter via this gate.

Midweek carparking for parishioners attending mass: There is no parking in the Rotunda area as the building works have commended. Fr Jim will open the tennis court gates for parking from 8.30am until 1.30pm during the week. The gates will be locked at 1.30pm so please remember to remove your car before then.

# Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012.*
