FRIDAY - STATIONS OF THE CROSS

(Morning) at 11am and (Evening) at 7pm starting March 8th till April 12th.

A prayerful experience of the Stations of the Cross provides us with the opportunity to enter into a meditation upon Jesus' final journey to the Cross. Many Catholics associate praying the Stations of the Cross with Lent and while not a re-enactment, the Stations do enable us to reflect on how in our own lives we follow in Jesus' path. Jesus' journey to the cross reminds us of the depth of his love for humanity, his capacity for self- sacrifice and his absolute commitment to the service of others.

SPORT AND WORK dominate most conversations between men. Many men find that they don't have anyone other than their wife they can really talk to. But every fortnight a group of good men from our parish get together to talk and pray together about how to be the best man, the best husband, the best father and the best friend they can be. ASH WEDNESDAY is on Wednesday March 6th. We'll be having Mass at 9am, 12.15pm and 7pm.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

We have the opportunity to watch a short while with Jesus with the reintroduction of Eucharist Adoration on a Thursday morning, immediately following the 9 am Mass and finishing with benediction at 12 o'clock. (Adoration will not take place if a Funeral Mass or School Liturgy has to be scheduled for a Thursday.) When St. Faustina was praying before Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, He showed her a vision. Each time a person entered the chapel and visited Jesus exposed in a monstrance, she saw His Divine Rays of Love and Mercy burst forth and encircle the world and everyone in it with graces and blessings. There are some formal prayers. During the first half hour after Mass the Rosary is recited followed by the short Divine Mercy Chaplet. At 11:30 the longer Chaplet and Litany of Divine Mercy is recited. However, from 10:00 am until 11:30 there is the quiet opportunity to offer private prayers of gratitude, petition and adoration.



Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012.*
