How to Pray: In this weekend's gospel passage we hear the disciples ask Jesus to teach them how to pray. His response is to teach them what we now call The Lord's Prayer. But Jesus wasn't just telling them to repeat these exact words. He was inviting them into a relationship in which they could call God "Father", just as he did, and to both ask for our own needs "our daily bread", as well as committing ourselves to God's values and purposes "your kingdom come".

Even armed with this advice, perhaps we still ask the same question: teach us how to pray. Over five weeks in August our parish is offering The First Spiritual Exercises, something akin to a spiritual bootcamp, with Gail Gill, Sam French and Fr Jim as your personal trainers. These exercises don't require any prior knowledge or experience in prayer. All that is needed is the desire to pray, and the commitment to pray for 30 minutes each day during the five weeks of the program. Using the creative guide to St Ignatius' First Spiritual Exercises, written by Fr Michael Hansen SJ, these sessions offer the experience of a four-week retreat in daily life. Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012.*
