

#### WORLD DAY OF THE SICK




Each year we celebrate the World Day of the Sick on the 11<sup>th</sup> February. This is also the feast day of Our Lady of Lourdes.

# From Fr David

Dear friends

This Sunday, the Church in Australia celebrates Word of God Sunday. It is a commemoration initiated by Pope Francis in January 2020. Ordinarily it is celebrated on the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time. However, with the variability of Australia Day, the Australian Bishops have asked that it be celebrated on the Fourth Sunday. It is a wonderful opportunity for us to reflect on the power of the Word of God: a Word that creates and saves. God gives us a word: and that Word Is Jesus, a word that says it all. It is a word that enables us to celebrate even in the face of adversity, that causes us to hope even in the midst of our sadness, that assures us of love even in the midst of fear. We are marking Word of God Sunday in a number of special ways in our church this weekend. We will reintroduce the use of the Book of the Gospels at Sunday Masses. We will also acknowledge the important ministry of Lector and give thanks to those who proclaim the Word of God for us. Our Coordinator of Lectors, Ditas Naguit, has prepared a beautiful parish guide for them and we will present them at each of our Masses. Like Mary, let us ponder the Word of God deep in our hearts so that new life might spring forth for us.

In recent conversation with our Marian Catholic Action Group, it became apparent that Thursday mornings are better suited for Rosary, Exposition and Benediction than Wednesday mornings. Therefore, we will revert to this former scheduling effective on Thursday 11 February. This means that going forward we will have Rosary, Exposition and Benediction on three occasions during the week: Thursday mornings, Thursday evenings and Saturday mornings. The 12.15pm Mass on Wednesdays will remain unchanged. On a Thursday morning, Exposition will conclude at midday with a simple Benediction. I am very grateful for the way in which this new scheduling has been suggested.

Thursday 11 February is the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, and it is the day the Church celebrates World Day of the Sick. To mark this international commemoration, we will offer the Sacrament of Anointing during our 9am Mass on that day.

We have begun to prepare for Ash Wednesday and the Season of Lent. This year we will offer three Masses on Ash Wednesday, 17 February: 9am, 12.15pm and 8pm. I will be meeting with our Liturgy Leaders on Tuesday 9 February to talk through how we can celebrate our Lent in as prayerful way as possible. It is my understanding that it has been a custom that different groups in our parish lead Friday Stations of the Cross during Lent. We would certainly wish to continue this. If you would like to offer to lead an occasion of the Stations might you let Nicole Gorman, our Parish Secretary know, and we will then coordinate this. We will pray the Stations each

Friday evening during Lent at 7.30pm. Also, we will reintroduce Morning Prayer before the weekday 9am Mass as from Thursday 18 February as we begin Lent.

It is wonderful that this this Sunday we reintroduce our Children's Liturgy of the Word at our 9am Mass, and also our Online Liturgy of the Word for Children on Sunday afternoon at 4pm. We are greatly blessed by our Children's Ministry at Our Lady of Dolours and we thank Angela Hague for her exceptional ministry in this regard.

Fr Joey Frez will be in Melbourne this weekend, commencing the Siloam program of the Heart of Life Centre. This is the orientation weekend for what is a two year parttime course of studies to form spiritual directors. We wish Fr Joey every blessing in this endeavour and a safe journey.
