
CAR PARKING ON FEAST DAY – 15/9/2019 Carparks Available:-

- Parish Staff Carpark (Entry via driveway off Archer St for disabled or elderly drivers only)
- St Pius X College Playground
 - Entry and Exit via Ferguson Lane up to 11am only
 - Entry and Exit via Kirk Street. Note, once all available car spaces are full, no further entry of cars will be allowed (until cars leave).

Traffic and Pedestrian Management:

- There will be 3 people managing traffic and pedestrians on the day from around 11am until completion of the Feast.
- Normal Sunday Mass parking arrangements will apply to 11am.
 Traffic and Pedestrian flow will be managed from 11am until end of Feast lunch and dispersion of most of the cars.
- Cars will only be allowed entry where there are sufficient spaces otherwise turned away.
- Feast activities to be confined to School Gym and areas around. No activities are to be held within the spaces allocated for parking.
- Traffic Managers will be stationed at Kirk Street entry, witches hats blocking Feast area and designated pedestrian area.

OUR PARISH PLANS: Last weekend members of the Parish Finance Committee shared with you what we've been able to do in the parish in this past year thanks to the generosity of our planned givers: new fans, repadded kneelers, a new member of staff and other maintenance and improvement. As we look to the year ahead there are many things we'd like to do in the parish:

- Upgrade the sound system in the church to overcome the reverberation and lack of intelligibility
- Start Community Dinners every Saturday night from October
- Run the Alpha program in March 2020, and other pastoral programs next year
- Employ a new staff member to be a small groups co-ordinator. We have so many new people approaching the parish that we now need to be able to facilitate their ongoing involvement in the parish
- Build a new baptism font on the sanctuary in stone to match altar
- Offer a Ministry Scholarship to a university student to engage them in a range of parish ministries.

Next weekend we will invite you to make a financial commitment to the parish to give in one of three ways: monthly direct, monthly credit card, or weekly cash envelopes. Making a commitment is important for the parish so we can budget and plan, but it is also good for you as it an expression of belonging, saying "this is my parish, I'm part of this". Belonging to a parish is not about geography, but about the intentional decision to be part of this community, no matter where you live.

CLERGY RETREAT: Fr John and Deacon Kevin will be on retreat with many of the clergy of our Diocese this week. Fr Jim will remain in the parish, and with Bishop David's help all weekday Masses will continue as usual. The recent reduction of weekday Masses was so that on weeks like this we are able to guarantee regular masses rather than having cancellations and communion services.

Working in a child-related ministry in the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay

Paid and volunteer workers who have direct face to face contact with children (under 18 years) are required by law to obtain a Working with Children Check number. Please note though exemptions may apply in some cases. The Parish is the employer of the paid or volunteer worker and therefore is required by law to verify the Working with Children Check number. All paid or volunteer workers engaged in a child-related role must have a clear Working with Children Check to work in a child-related ministry. This disclosure references the legislation, *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act* 2012.
