First time here? Some information for you: *Toilets* at St Gerard's are in the building directly behind the church. Toilets at OLHC are accessed from the street on the other side of the tree. *Communion*: If you are Catholic and usually receive Communion you can come forward to any minister to receive the Body of Christ on your hand. If you are not Catholic, or for children who have not yet prepared for First Communion come forward with your hands crossed on your heart to receive a blessing. *Giving*: If you'd like to support our parish financially there are a few ways to do this. There are two money boxes at the back of St Gerard's and the middle of OLHC. Pastoral Revenue / First Collection supports the priests of our parish and diocese, and the Church Account / Second Collection supports all the ministries of our parish which you read about in this newsletter. A tap & go machine at the entrance to the church gives a donation to our parish. *Thank you for your generosity*.

Worship together: As Catholics we live our faith in many ways, but the heart of our faith is always our gathering together for Mass each week. We have four weekend Masses at each of our churches. *OLHC Epping* has Saturday at 5pm and Sunday at 8.30am, 10.15am and 7pm. *St Gerard's Carlingford* has Saturday at 6pm and Sunday at 7.45am, 9.30am and 5pm. This gives lots of options for people's busy lives! Everyone is welcome at every Mass, and we have a particular focus on families with school aged children at the 9.30am Mass, and

on teenagers and young adults at 5pm Sundays at St Gerard's. We know that some people find noise and crowds difficult, and for them the 7.45am Mass at St Gerard's is a quieter, gentler Mass which might be a comfortable place to be. Come and join more than 1000 people who come for worship every weekend.

Getting Involved: Everybody has some gift or talent to offer to the service of God in the Church. Keep an eye out in this bulletin in the new year for some new opportunities to get involved. To our hundreds of existing volunteers – thank you for all you have done this year. We'd like to thank you in person at our annual Volunteers Mass and Dinner on Tues Feb 18th. Look out for an invitation from your ministry coordinator early in the new year.



Christmas can be tough and sometimes we need help: CatholicCare is the social care agency of our diocese. They offer services for domestic and family violence, homelessness, parenting, relationship counselling, aged care, foster care and emergency relief. Take a flyer from the back of the church or go to www.catholiccaredbb.org.au. For counselling contact 1800 324 924. The priests of the parish are always available. The parish office 9876 2853 diverts to either Fr Jim or Fr Aldrin after hours. The St Vincent De Paul Society offers practical assistance to people in financial need. Call the Hornsby regional office on 9477 5022 during office hours and they'll arrange for two of our local Vinnies volunteers to come and visit you at home.

Social Justice: It is part of our Catholic faith that we are committed to social justice, that is, the transformation of society into a place where God's justice takes place. In 2024 our parish social justice group has focused on environment (recycling and Clean Up day), supporting Jesuit Refugee Services (jrs.org.au) and partnering with Parramatta Women's Shelter and Prison Fellowship. We're also a partner of the Sydney Alliance (**sydneyalliance.org.au**) which will gives us access to a broad coalition of civil society groups working together for the common good.


Enrolment information will be emailed to all who celebrated Confirmation in 2024 at our parish and to all who have previously enquired and are on the email list.





BACK TO SCHOOL! **Mums4Refugees NSW**, a local charity of mums and carers, collects new school supplies for refugee and asylum seeker children. These kits, distributed by Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS) in Parramatta, provided over 120 backpacks to students last year.

As part of the Epping-Carlingford parish's **five pillars of missionary discipleship**, the Faith Formation Team focuses on **Pillar 1 – Connect, and Pillar 4 – Grow**. The team supports spiritual growth by developing and sustaining programs that deepen faith, encourage discipleship, and foster community. These programs are offered in various formats, including small group meetings, Zoom meetups, video-dinner discussions, year-round or 4-12 week sessions, and community events like Pentecost praise and worship gatherings. The team currently consists of: Gail Gill, Joanna Mak, Lynne Slocombe, Marie Black, Mery Auwyang, Philip Senger, Leon D'Sylva, Regina Soeryanto and Vivienne Saverimuttu.

We are re-capping some of the programs that are running or was done in 2024:

- The Bible Timeline runs throughout the year held Tuesday evenings 7pm on Zoom. For more information, contact phillip.senger@eppcarl.org.au
- **Reflection and Meditation on Sunday's reading** runs during school term. It is a small group gathering held Friday mornings 10.15am at St. Gerard's meeting room contact mariefblack3@gmail.com

Term 1

- Lenten groups ran for 5 weeks prior to Easter, held at different times through the week at OLHC and St. Gerard's.
- **Spiritual exercise** a second series ran for 5 weeks, held at different times through the week at OLHC and St Gerard's. The Spiritual Exercises, created by St. Ignatius Loyola, are meditations and prayers designed to deepen one's relationship with God. They are often experienced as a daily-life retreat with prayer and spiritual guidance but have been adapted for modern needs.

Term 2

- On Saturday, May 18th, the parish celebrated **Pentecost** at St. Gerard's, organised by the Faith Formation Team. After the Vigil Mass, the Holy Rosary was recited in seven languages, followed by Adoration, spirit-filled worship led by youth, testimonies, and a supper with food donated by parishioners.
- **Testimonies:** Pentecost Night was a beautiful and solemn event. The multilingual rosary was very meaningful, and it was wonderful to see the youth participating with praise and worship songs. Their involvement made the event even more special. ~Dennis Carpio

Term 3

- Metanoia: 10 half hour episodes on Formed by Fr Dave from Wild Goose. Metanoia is an 11-part series exploring spiritual conversion through repentance, transforming how we see Jesus, the Father, ourselves, and others. A follow-up to The Wild Goose, it deepens understanding of Jesus' message and invites viewers to grow in faith.
- Testimonies: My experience with Metanoia was very positive. The guests were all very friendly and I enjoyed the dinner provided each week. I learnt more about my Catholic faith and the videos were informative. It has made me more enthusiastic about my faith and with attending Mass and has been helpful to me as a recent convert to Catholicism a year ago. ~Alexander
