Circle of Friends: The Circle of Friends ministry began during the covid lockdowns, when a team of volunteers began phoning parishioners on our parish database to stay in touch and check on their wellbeing. Some of the relationships made in that time have continued with



regular phone calls to this day. We are now reinvigorating the ministry, with several new volunteers allowing us to call a greater number of people.

We recognise that loneliness continues without a lockdown for many people who have limited mobility or whose family and friends have moved away. So if you get a call from a friendly stranger in the coming weeks, please do answer it. Many of the calls will be to landlines as we don't have everyone's current mobile numbers.

A Circle of Friends volunteer will always identify themselves as being from the parish and will never ask you for money or financial details. Rather, they will ask how we can best support you in your faith life, which might include giving you a lift to Mass, a visit at home, or the sacraments of anointing and Communion brought to you at home. If you are in doubt, take their name and phone the parish office to verify them.

Why are we doing this now? Each year the Parish Pastoral Council identifies some pastoral priorities. Whilst youth and young families are almost always top of the list, this year we discerned the needs of older parishioners, and those who have previously been active in the parish but are no longer able to be active. We hope that the Circle of Friends ministry will be able to help us connect with them. We also look forward to recommencing a monthly Senior's Mass and lunch at OLHC, and to increasing the number of ministers taking Communion to the housebound.


