Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

Also known as Candlemas, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is celebrated on the 2nd February. It commemorates Mary and Joseph presenting Jesus at the temple 40 days after His birth, fulfilling Mosaic Law. It also marks their encounter with



Simeon and Anna, who recognised Jesus as the Light of the World. The Church blesses candles on this day, symbolizing Christ's light shining in darkness. Families often bring their own candles to be blessed, signifying the growing light leading to Easter.

To celebrate this feast, on the weekend of the 1st/2nd February, you are invited to bring your Baptismal candles or other specially blessed candles when you attend Mass that weekend. Bring one or bring a stack of candles to be blessed for use over the year! Children are also welcome to bring their Baptismal candle.




"The thought of NOT cooking dinner on 10 consecutive Tuesdays was a great motivator to attend **Metanoia** with my husband Geoff.


