


NEW OLHC BUILDING UPDATE

Getting ready for the new OLHC building: Even though the delivery date keeps getting pushed back (presently the end of September), anticipation is growing for our new building and carpark. We can now see that the forecourt is getting paved and there are plants and trees in the planter boxes, so we know we're getting close. It's time to start to think about some of the logistics, and this week we'll cover the carpark.

OLHC Carpark: There will be 95 parking spaces in our new underground carpark. For reference, this is twice as many as we previously had when we parked on the school playground, because we will have two levels of parking. The entry will be at 6 Cambridge St, just where the car park entry was previously. A separate carpark will later open for the residents of The Cambridge Tower at the northern end of the site.

Upon entry to the carpark your number plate will be scanned and the boom gate will lift. We need to control access to the carpark, otherwise it would soon be over run by commuters eager to find a parking spot near the station, but we will welcome commuters and shoppers who will be able to use the carpark for \$5 per hour, as this will help fund



the running costs of the building, so that the carpark can always be free for parishioners attending Mass and other functions. There will be a validation process around this.

A short period of free parking for school drop-offs, pick-ups, and couriers, etc will be available. The exit boom gate will also be programmed to allow enough time for parking during Mass and other events. In the coming month, we will contact ministers like musicians, welcomers, and hospitality servers for their car number plates to program additional free parking time. If you visit the parish office or attend a small group, you can provide your car number plate on the day for free parking. It might take some trial and error as we work on the best settings to make access easy for our parishioners whilst still maintaining security.



SOCIAL JUSTICE




There is no place like home – but for many having a home is not a reality. The causes may be diverse, but the impact is the same – a loss of dignity and a sense of hopelessness.




