

Theft from parish office: We wish to inform you that unfortunately, on the evening of Saturday 30 November 2024 there was a break in at our Carlingford Parish office. The door had been forced and we were devastated to find that the safe had been broken into and some Pastoral Works Fund Broken Bay envelopes were stolen that contained personal information and credit card details.

As soon as we discovered this, we notified the police.

Information that may have been stolen includes credit card details, parishioners' names, phone numbers, email addresses and addresses.

Please be assured that we are engaging with all the relevant authorities and working to assist everyone as much as possible.

We have been contacting parishioners directly who made donations by card, and those who made a cash or cheque donation and who asked for a receipt.

However, if you made a cash donation to our Pastoral Works Fund at St Gerard Majella Carlingford, between 3 November and 24 November 2024, and provided your personal information on the envelope, but did not ask for a receipt, I ask that you contact me as soon as possible, as your personal information may have been stolen when the safe was broken into.

Please exercise caution if you receive messages or notifications in respect of accounts that you are not expecting and check any suspicious activity by contacting the relevant institution directly or via an app, rather than by using any contact details that are provided in an email or text message and do not provide any information such as your date of birth to any person who contacts you purporting to be from your bank before independently checking with your bank.


I understand you will be concerned by this news, and I apologise for any inconvenience it has caused.








Enjoy talks, discussions, music, prayer and food. We can't wait to see you there!
