OLHC Development: We are still expecting to have access to our new building and carpark by the weekend of July 28th, with informal celebrations after every Mass that weekend, and a formal opening and blessing with Bishop Anthony on August 10th.

This week you'll see that there are **new temporary toilets** on the forecourt which are necessary so that the previous toilets can be taken away and the driveway and landscaping completed.



Mass Attendance: During May we counted the number of people at each Mass, as we do every year. The average number of people taking part in the 8 weekend Masses totals 1120, which is a 10% increase on last year, and brings us back to the pre-pandemic levels of 2018 and 2019. Most Masses have held steady, with the biggest growth being at the St Gerard's Sunday night Mass.

Volunteers: Thank you to the 70+ people who volunteered for new ministries at Pentecost. Your names and contacts have been distributed to the leaders of ministries who will then reach out to you to invite you into the ministry.

It's not too late – you can still take a green or pink volunteer form from the back of the church and bring it back any time. If you haven't yet heard from a ministry leader, please contact the parish office.



Planned Giving Envelopes are now ready for collection at the back of the Church. To reduce costs, we have adjusted the number range, so some envelope numbers may have changed. Those who give electronically will not be affected. Receipts for the current year will be mailed after June.



Clergy Conference: Fr Jim, Fr Aldrin and Deacon Richard will be away at the diocesan clergy conference from **June 11-14**. The parish office will be open as usual (with the exception of the Monday public holiday) and *communion services will replace weekday Masses*.

There will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, but **not reconciliation on Tuesday 11th at OLHC**.

Pastoral Works Broken Bay is the very real expression of our Catholic charity in our neighbourhood as we are the hands and feet of Our Lord. Our Lady Help of Christians Fund: On Sunday May 26th parishioners attended a forum at OLHC to discuss the soon to be established “Our Lady Help of Christians Fund”. This Fund will be the container for receiving the money from the OLHC redevelopment.

There was strong agreement at this forum, aligning with ongoing discussion at the Parish Finance Committee and the Parish Pastoral Council, that this money be invested so that the capital is preserved and produces an income for the parish for the next 100 years. There was also agreement that we want to be generous as a parish, and that the income be used not only for the benefit of our parish, but also for other parishes in our diocese, and for a range of charities.

The Pastoral Council and Finance Committee will continue to work on developing a constitution to govern this fund, which will be fully available for parishioners to view.
