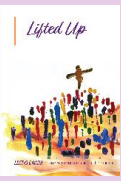

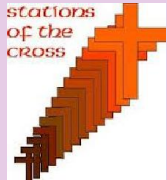

**UPCOMING DIOCESAN PASTORAL CARE COURSE: For Anyone in the Hospital Visitation Ministry**

Volunteer Catholic Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion visit hospitals throughout the Diocese of Broken Bay providing comfort and care to Catholic patients. NSW Health requires that 40 hours of training is completed to perform this important role. The Diocesan Pastoral Care Course is open to those who already volunteer in a hospital context, or in local health and aged care facilities, and also to those who might be deciding if they are suited to this ministry.
