BISHOP PETER COMENSOLI APPOINTED AS ARCHBISHOP ELECT OF MELBOURNE as announced Friday June 29, 2018



"It is with great joy, mixed with great sadness, that we share with you the news of the appointment of Most Rev Peter A Comensoli as the ninth Archbishop of Melbourne. Despite this immense loss for our community of Broken Bay, this is wonderful news for the Church in Australia." *Annie Carrett, Communications Team: Diocese of Broken Bay*

Bishop Peter writes:

"Having been appointed by Pope Francis, I recognise the challenge he has placed before me to lead God's people in Melbourne tenderly, mercifully and joyfully. As a shepherd after the Heart of Jesus, the Lord expects me to reach out to all with a Gospel boldness. Therefore, I place my stewardship of the Archdiocese of Melbourne under the intercession of Ss Peter and Paul, on whose feast day this announcement is made."

Archbishop-elect Comensoli will now lead the Archdiocese of Melbourne after serving as the Bishop of Broken Bay over the past three and a half years. *"I will miss tremendously the wonderful people – laity, religious and clergy – of Broken Bay. For the all too brief time that it has been my privilege to serve them, I am proud to have been their friend and shepherd. Now I look forward to getting to know the people of Melbourne. And as a northerner, I will need some guidance around that mysterious code of football called AFL!"*

"I extend my deep gratitude to Archbishop Hart for his faithful leadership and strength of Christian character over the past 17 years. His welcome to me has been warm, generous and encouraging, and I wish him every blessing in his retirement."

And in his letter of July 2 to the people of our diocese, the Archbishop-elect writes about the actions now in place: *"The office of the Vicar General ceased as of 29 June 2018 in accord with canon 481 as when the function of the diocesan bishop was suspended the office of the Vicar General did so as well. This also applied to the office of the Episcopal Vicar. Fr David Ranson has been canonically mandated to assist me during my time as Apostolic Administrator in the practical matters of the Diocese that require my attention during this period. As I take on this new ministry, I ask that you pray for me, as the people of my first Diocese will always be in my prayers."*
