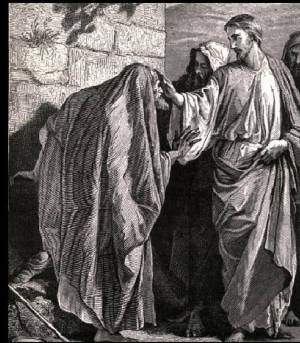

LENT COMMENCES THIS WEEK ON ASH WEDNESDAY: FEBRUARY 14

Please refer to our 'In Your Parish This Week' for all Mass times on Ash Wednesday

We are reminded once more that Lent is a time of preparation for Easter, the high point of the Church's liturgical year. We are asked to focus in a special way on turning our hearts towards God and we need to find ways to achieve this which are personally meaningful to us, and the following Lenten practices of penance may be of help to you:

- Fasting and abstinence from meat** on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday
- Prayer:** Bible Study, Lenten programmes, Stations of the Cross, praying the Rosary, Mass attendance etc.
- Self Denial:** Not eating meat on Fridays, giving up something you love and donating the cost of it to the poor.
- Giving special attention** to someone who is poor, sick, elderly, lonely or overburdened.

WE ARE CALLED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LENTEN DAYS OF FASTING & REPARATION IN SORROW FOR CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 14 TO SATURDAY FEBRUARY 17

The concluding report from the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse was handed down last December. As a Church and as a society, we are now tasked to fully understand its recommendations and build a culture that rigorously ensures the care and safety of all vulnerable people.

As a spiritual response to the report, and to the great wounds it brought into the light, the Australian bishops have proclaimed the days from Ash Wednesday until the following Saturday Days of Fasting and Reparation in sorrow for child sexual abuse and the healing of victims. In addition to the work that has been undertaken in the area of the protection of children and vulnerable adults, the Days of Fasting and Reparation are an authentically Catholic response to supplement those efforts.
