We fly to thy patronage O holy Mother of God, despise not our petitions in our necessities but deliver us always from all dangers, O glorious and blessed Virgin. Amen.

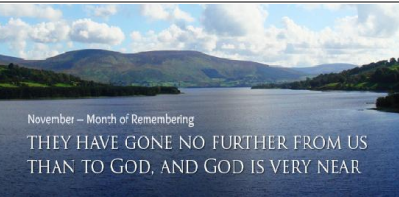
