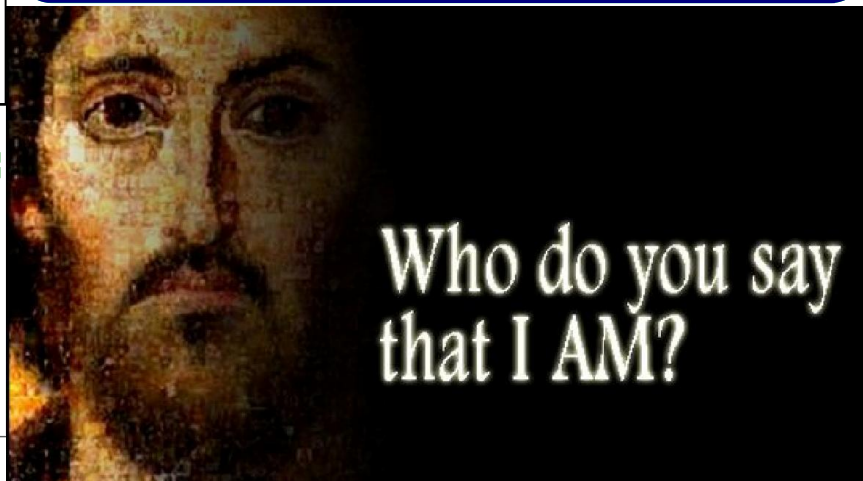

Who do you say  
that I AM?

Mark built his whole story around the moment of declaration by the disciples about who they believed Jesus really is: 'You are the Christ!' Once, the disciples had recognised his full identity, they were ready to be presented with the demands of being disciples, people who had chosen to follow his way. Today, this gospel presents us with the same challenge. By assembling here we are declaring our belief in the identity of Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the Father. But having declared that faith, we now have to face the challenge of following his way. This way is the way of renouncing self, of taking up our crosses, and of being prepared to see in his way a radically different way of living.

**WHAT DO YOU THINK GOD IS ASKING OF US IN AUSTRALIA AT THIS TIME?**

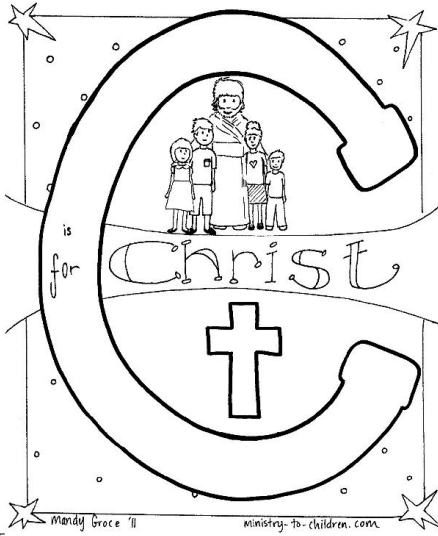
Last week our parish met with as many of our ministry leaders as were able to attend and in turn they will be in contact with their teams to offer an opportunity to listen and dialogue with them.

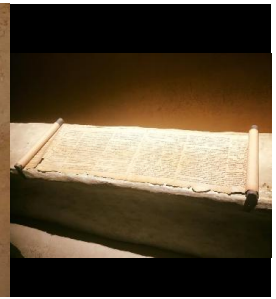

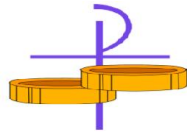

## SAFEGUARDING AGAINST ELDER ABUSE



If a person discloses elder abuse:  
**Respond** with kindness and maintain an attitude that does not threaten, blame, or make judgements about the person, the abuser, or the choices they have made.  
**Believe** the person and be willing to listen.  
**Let** the person know that they can count on you to be supportive.  
**Provide** choices, not interventions — empower the person to take control of their life.  
**Let** the person know [even if they deny abuse has happened] that it's not their fault, they are not alone [abuse can happen to anyone], and that there is help available.
